

Tenure-Track or Tenured Faculty Positions in Big-Data Analytics and Information Systems at UCL School of Management

The UCL School of Management invites applications for tenure-track or tenured positions in Big-Data Analytics and Information Systems with an anticipated start date 1st September 2016.

Assistant/Associate/Full Professor in Big-Data Analytics and Information Systems: We are looking for candidates with strong research potential (or demonstrated excellence for senior candidates) in Big-Data Analytics and Information Systems. We are particularly interested in candidates with a quantitative focus on emerging business problems in information technology, business analytics, digital strategy, social media, among others. Candidates are expected to publish articles in top management journals such as *Information Systems Research*, *Management Science*, *MIS Quarterly*, and/or in other leading science and engineering journals. We encourage both junior and senior applications with a PhD in Information Systems, Computer Science, or a related field.

Successful candidates will join the Analytics & Operations research group in the School of Management and are expected to teach Analytics and/or Information Systems courses in our undergraduate and Masters programs or in joint programs with other departments such as Computer Science.

University College London (UCL) is London's leading multi-disciplinary university and one of the world's foremost research universities, with a consistent ranking in the top 20 of the world's best universities. UCL has 35,000 students and 11,000 staff. Academic staff and former students of UCL have won 32 Nobel Prizes; the most recent addition, in 2014, was John O'Keefe (Physiology/Medicine).

The UCL School of Management consists of three research groups: Strategy & Entrepreneurship, Organisations & Innovation, and Analytics & Operations, each having a PhD program. The school also offers BSc and MSc programs in management, entrepreneurship, information management for business, and management science and business analytics.
